(an Alabama Nonprofit Corporation)

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Alabama.

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the corporation is SEDGEFIELD HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC., hereinafter referred to as the "Association." The address of the Association is 169 Dauphin Street, Suite 101, Mobile, Alabama 36602.

ARTICLE II
DURATION

The corporate existence will begin upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation. This corporation shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved in accordance with the provisions herein contained or in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama.

ARTICLES III
PURPOSES

The Association does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to its members. The Association's specific purposes are to provide for the maintenance and preservation of that certain tract of property (the "Property") described in that Subdivision Plat, recorded as Instrument No. 967467 on Slide No. 2260F in the Probate Office of Baldwin County, Alabama (the "Subdivision Plat") for the mutual advantage and benefit of the members of this Association, who shall be owners of lots within the Property. To promote the health, safety and welfare of the owners of lots in the Property and any additions thereto as may hereafter be brought within the jurisdiction of this Association, the Association shall have and exercise the following authority and powers:

- (a) To exercise all of the powers and privileges and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in the Declaration of Restrictions & Covenants of Sedgfield recorded in the Office of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama as Instrument No. 967770 ("Restrictions") which are hereby incorporated herein by reference.
- (b) To fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means all charges and assessments, pursuant to the terms of the Restrictions or as the Board of Directors may determine are necessary. To pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the Association.
- (c) To acquire, by gift, purchase or otherwise, own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the Association.
- (d) To borrow money and to mortgage, pledge or hypothecate any and all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred.
- (e) To dedicate, sell or transfer all or any part of the common area shown on the Subdivision Plat to any public agency, authority or utility for such purposes, subject to the procedure as established in the Restrictions and such conditions as may be agreed to by the members.
- (f) To participate in mergers and consolidations with other nonprofit corporations organized for similar purposes.
- (g) To act as purchasing agent for goods and services for the Association and for the benefit of the members.
- (h) To have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Alabama, by law, may now or hereafter have or exercise.

**ARTICLE IV
MEMBERSHIP**

JAMES A. YANCE, JR., RICHARD D. INGE and KIMBERLY BARNETT shall be the initial members of the Association for a period of two years from today's date and every person or entity who is a record owner of a lot within the property shall be a member of the Association. The foregoing is not intended to include persons or entities who hold an interest merely as security for the performance of an obligation. Except for the initial members of the Association, the membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of any lot. The Association shall have one class of voting membership, and each lot shall be entitled to one vote. The lots owned by YIA DEVELOPMENT, LLC shall be voted by JAMES A. YANCE, JR. or RICHARD D. INGE, or the subsequent owner or owners of YIA DEVELOPMENT, LLC.

**ARTICLE V
BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Board of Directors, who shall be members of the Association. The number of Directors of the Association shall not be less than three (3) nor more than five (5). The name and address of the persons who are to act in the initial capacity of Director until the selection and qualification of their successors are:

Directors shall serve for a term of one year, and shall hold office until qualified successors are duly elected at the next annual meeting of members and have taken office. Directors may be re-elected for successive terms.

**ARTICLE VI
REMOVAL OF DIRECTOR**

Any director may be removed from office, with or without cause, by at least a majority vote of all Members, at any duly called meeting of Members. A special Association Meeting to remove a director or directors from office may be called by ten percent (10%) of all Members giving notice of the meeting. The notice shall state the purpose of the meeting and shall be given to all Members in writing at least one week prior to the Association Meeting.

Any vacancy occurring in the Board may be filled by a majority vote of the remaining Board members, except that a vacancy resulting from removal of a director by the Members shall be filled by a vote of the membership.

**ARTICLE VII
DIRECTOR COMPENSATION**

Directors shall receive no compensation for their services unless expressly provided for in resolutions adopted by the Members.

**ARTICLE VIII
REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT**

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 169 Dauphin Street, Suite 101, Mobile, Alabama 36602. The name of the initial Registered Agent of the Association at that address is James A. Yance, Jr.

**ARTICLE IX
OFFICERS**

Subject to the direction of the Board, the affairs of this Association shall be administered by its officers, as designated in the By-laws of this Association. Said officers shall be elected annually by the Board. The names and addresses of the officers who shall serve until the first annual meeting of the Board are as follows:

ARTICLE X BY-LAWS

The By-Laws of this Association shall be adopted by the first Board and recorded among the public records of Mobile County, Alabama. The By-Laws may be altered, amended, modified or repealed in a manner provided for in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE XI AMENDMENTS

This Association reserves the right to amend or repeal any of the provisions contained in these Articles or any amendments hereto with the approval of two-thirds (2/3) of the Members. No amendment shall conflict with the Restrictions.

ARTICLE XII SUPREMACY

These Articles and By-Laws are subject to the Restrictions and in the event of a conflict, the Restrictions shall govern. In the event of a conflict between the Articles and By-Laws, the Articles shall govern.

**ARTICLE XIII
INDEMNIFICATION**


This Association shall indemnify and hold harmless any and all of its present or former directors, officers, employees or agents, to the full extent permitted by law. Said indemnification shall include, but not be limited to the expenses, including the cost of any judgments, fines, settlements and counsel's fees actually and necessarily paid or incurred in connection with any action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, and any appeal thereof, to which any such persons or his legal representative may be made a party or may be threatened to be made a party by reason of his being or having been a director, officer, employee or agent as herein provided.
